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Casy Exams



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Rationale

In order for learners to acquire new vocabulary, periodic review of vocabulary items is essential. Simply introducing students to words and expressions in one chapter, and then moving on to the next chapter without looking back, is not enough. The reviews and exams included in this supplementary package were designed to help students remember the form, meaning and usage of vocabulary and expressions included in *Easy Nursing English* as they move through the textbook. These exercises were also designed for instructors who wish to combine vocabulary review with formal means of assessment in their courses.

Application

One *Easy Review* exercise has been made for each of the five sections in the textbook. These exercises may be used by instructors during class or given as homework after students have completed a section in the textbook. Students may be asked to do these exercises alone, or in pairs or groups in order to make the task a collaborative activity. Students can first try to do the tasks with books closed, and then use their books to find the remaining answers. The last exercise in each *Easy Review* worksheet attempts to integrate vocabulary used in each chapter of the targeted section. Instructors may print out copies for each student or each group, or use an overhead projector to display the tasks in order to save paper.

The *Easy Exams* were designed as a more formal means of assessing students' retention of vocabulary and expressions introduced in the textbook. There are two exams: one for Part One of the textbook (Basic medical words), and the second for Part Two (Basic communication). Each exam may be used either as a mid-term or final examination, or instructors may refer to these exams when drafting their own examinations. These exams may also be used as review activities.

目的

新しい語彙を増やそうとする学習者にとって,定期的に各語を復習することは重要です.各章で単語と表現を学生に簡単に紹介して,ふり返ることなく次の章へ進むというのは十分とはいえません.この補足教材の復習問題と試験問題は,「看単!」を進めてきた学生が,収載されている語彙・表現のかたちや意味,使い方を覚えられるように作られています.また,授業の復習と正式な評価の手段を組み合わせたい教員のことも考慮して作成されています.

使い方

Easy Reviews は、教科書の5つのセクションごとに作成されています。学生が各セクションを終えたときに、教員が授業中に利用する、または宿題として与えるといった使い方ができます。学生は一人で、あるいは共同作業としてペアかグループで、この課題を行うことになるでしょう。最初は本を見ずに課題を行い、回答できなかった箇所は本を開いて調べることができます。各 Easy Review の最後の問題は該当するセクションの各章から語彙を集めようと試みています。教員は各学生・グループにこの課題のプリントを配布するか、または紙を節約するためにプロジェクターで映す方法もとれます。

Easy Exams は、学生が本書で紹介された語彙・表現を覚えたかどうかをはかる、より正式な手段となるよう作成されています。 2 編が用意されていて、1 つめは Part One (Basic medical words)、2 つめは Part Two (Basic communication) の試験問題です。中間試験または最終試験として利用できますし、教員が独自の試験問題を作成する際の参考にもなるでしょう。復習課題としての利用もできます。
